



Features:

The machine shreds hard wood, soft wood, particle board, MDF, cardboard, plastics and other materials



Functional principle:

Materials to be shredded enter the shredding machine through the overhead filling funnel. The hydraulik controlled slide gradually pushes the materials against the rotor and its rotating blades.

Rotor

The rotor is made of heavy duty solid steel into which contours are tuned. The blade holders are then welded into these contours. Two blade holders with cutting teeth are placed in each contour which yields larger and more even cutting along the full width of the rotor. This reduces wear on the machine and the main bearings.



Cutting Blades

The blades can be supplied in different versions. There are square and concave blades depending upon the type of product to be shredded. Depending upon the selected version, they can be used in groups of 4 or 8.




Sieve

The hole-sizes in the sieve determine the size of the chips. Smaller holes yield smaller chips. The disired size of the chips generally depends on your subsequent use or processing of the material, e.g. briquettes, woodchipheating, etc.



Turbo coupler

An additional turbo coupler is built into larger electrical drives. This allows the machine to be initialised smoothly. Power spikes which would normally occur upon start-up are reduced.




Switch cabinet

The switch cabinet is equipped with an PLC (programmable logic controller). The switch cabinet can be directly attached to the machine or mounted externally onto a wall. All operator elements are freely accessible and clearly arranged.

This can also be provided with a touch-screen upon request. This displays possible control errors (save maintenance costs).

Options:

■ Permanent magnet

Foreign bodies such as nails, screws, metal brackets and drywall screws can be removed after the shredding process with a permanent magnet. This is simply placed inside the chippings chute.

Switch cabinet with touch-screen

The electrical switch cabinet can also be equipped with a touch-screen as an option. This displays possible control errors (save maintenance costs).

■ Funnel shape

Upon request, the shape of the funnel can be adapted to suit the customer's requirements.

■ Special machines

The PZ series can also be used in the recycling industry. The stronger versions of the machines are more appropriate for plastics shredding.
