

- More efficient processing center capacity utilization

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

- Clamping element positions are precisely determined
- Handling programs are generated for the loader TBA 330 and transport of finished workpieces out of the machine
- Job list control for automatic sequential processing of raw panels
- Part identification by means of bar code

- Patented handling solution for extension arm machines
- Positions raw panels on the machine table for dividing using the nesting technique
- Utilizes the processing center's high-performance power control PC 85 system without additional programming input

Handling reliability

The intelligently selected optional equipment offers an outstanding degree of process reliability.

- The optical drop sensor recognizes additionally adhering panels
- Pneumatic pressure tappets prevent the panel slipping on release by the suction cups

The matrix adapter panel turns the processing center into a "panel dividing center" (retrofitting possible at any time).






Workpiece gripper


The newly developed workpiece gripper permits the sized parts to be transported individually from the grid table top into the processing area.





- High output even for batch size 1 production
- Versatile vacuum clamp available for different workpiece geometries
- Scope for flexible upgrading up to a production cell



Modular drilling technology

Different drilling heads with variable speed of up to 7,500 rpm and a spindle locking mechanism for extremely high loads, such as with HPL processing. The wide range of addon units available permits drilling heads to be upgraded in line with your specific needs. A supplementary routing spindle permits the deployment of tools such as a special router bit without the need for a working spindle tool change.

Gluing technology

The gluing unit turns the processing center into an edge banding machine for workpieces in any shape and with any type of edging.

This revolutionary new technique ensures:


